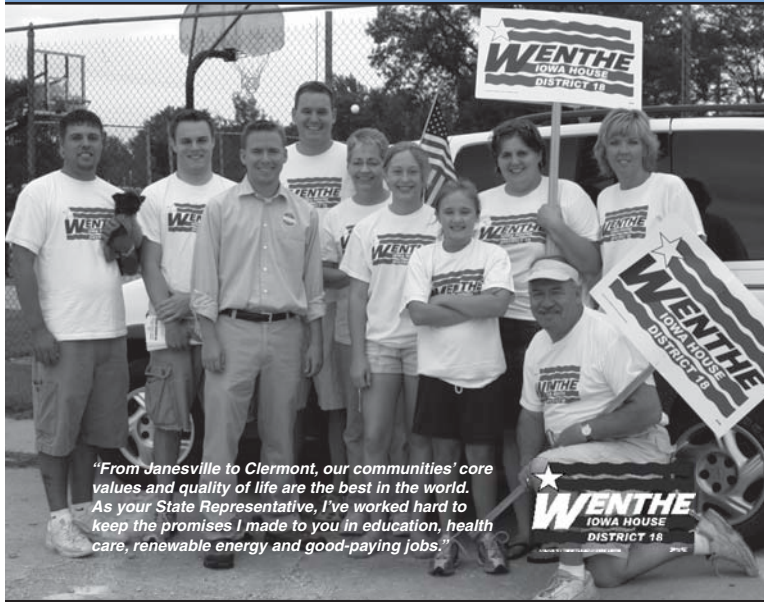


# State Representative Andrew Wenthe
